

Spain - Care and Culture

Day 1:

Arrive at Madrid Barajas International Airport and meet our in-country coordinator. Transfer to accommodation followed by orientation. In the evening the group will enjoy a welcome dinner in a typical Spanish restaurant with a Flamenco Show.

Day 2:

The group will enjoy a guided tour of the historical city center of Madrid. Following this, they will visit the Museo del Prado, which contains one of the world's finest collections of European Art, before visiting the Royal Gardens prior to dinner.

Day 3:

The group will be given a guided tour of the Royal Palace, the official residence of the Spanish Royal Family and the largest functioning Royal Palace in Europe. In the afternoon, the group will take the high-speed train to Valencia before being transferred to their accommodation in the city.



Day 4:

The group will take a crash-course in Spanish from 9am until 2pm. In the afternoon, the group will be given a guided tour of the historical city center of Valencia by bicycle, before dinner in a local restaurant.

Day 5:

In the morning, the group will have a guided visit to the University of Valencia Faculty of Medicine, followed by a visit to a private clinic. In the afternoon, they will have a chance to interview a panel of nurses about their experiences.

Day 6:

The group will have a guided visit of La Fe Nursing School, followed by a tour of the world-famous La Fe Hospital. Lunch will be had with the nursing students. In the afternoon, the group will volunteer at a local volunteer foundation.

Day 7:

The group will visit Sagunto Castle, north of Valencia. In the evening, they will take part in a Paella Master Class in the evening.

Day 8:


The group will spend the day at the volunteer foundation.

Day 9:

The group will visit Peñíscola Castle and tour around the old town. After a debrief and award ceremony, there will be a farewell dinner for the group.

Day 10:

The group will be transferred back to Madrid International Airport for their flight home.



Program Features

A. Pre-Departure Support

Comprehensive pre-departure support from World Endeavors staff members, including a pre-departure orientation or webinar as requested. Participants will also receive a personalized pre-departure handbook.

B. 24-hour Spain-based support

Our experienced Valencia-based coordinators will be available 24 hours a day to provide support for the group.

C. In-Country Orientation

Upon arriving in Spain, the group will receive an in-country orientation from our in-country coordinator. This orientation will introduce them to Spanish culture, health and safety issues, and the schedule for the program.

D. Language Class & Materials

Crash Course Spanish lesson will be included, with no extra fee for materials.

E. Group Accommodations

In Madrid – Accommodation will be in shared rooms in a centrally located hostel.

In Valencia – Accommodation will be in a Private Residence Hall with single or double rooms for students. Students will always have their own beds. Group leaders will have single rooms in all locations.

F. Meals

Breakfast and dinner are included each day, with the exception of arrival and departure days. Arrival (just dinner), Departure (just breakfast).

G. In-Country Transportation

Buses or trains will be used to transfer the group between Madrid and Valencia. Within each city, local public transportation will be utilized. The group will travel on a private bus for day trips.
