Program Summary

You will spend two weeks assisting locals with much needed construction, repairs, and renovations, learning about a country and people as you do it.

Accommodation

Participants stay at our center, a gated-community in Accra. Rooms are generally dorm style and are separated between male and female. Programs are located about 20 - 40 minutes away from the house.

Program Inclusions

A. Pre-Departure Support

Comprehensive pre-departure support from World Endeavors staff members, including a pre-departure orientation. Participants will also receive a personalized pre-departure handbook.

B. 24-hour Ghana-based support

Our experienced Ghana-based coordinators will be available 24 hours a day to provide support.

C. In-Country Orientation

In-depth in-country orientation introducing the group to Ghanaian culture, health and safety issues, the project, and the schedule for the program.

D. Group Accommodations

Participants will stay in dormitory rooms in the accommodation, separated by gender.

E. Meals

3 meals a day will be provided during the week, 2 meals a day on weekend days.

F. Airport Reception

Participants will be met and picked up from Kotoka International Airport in Accra.

G. Volunteering Project

Participants will spend 9 days volunteering.

H. Comprehensive Travel Medical Insurance

Group participants will be enrolled in travel medical insurance, which also covers personal belongings.
