

Healthcare in Argentina

Day 1:

The group will arrive into Buenos Aires and meet our in-country coordinator. After settling into the accommodation, there will be a thorough in-country orientation followed by a city tour of Buenos Aires. In the evening, the group will enjoy a Welcome Dinner in a typical Argentinian restaurant.

Day 2:

The group will take a crash course in Spanish, followed by a guided tour of the Latin American Art Museum & Museum of Modern Art. In the evening, the group will learn how to cook a variety of Argentine specialties.

Day 3:

The group will spend the day at an early childhood development center, learning about the work that's being done to care for the children.



Day 4:

The group will visit a shelter for homeless children and adolescents and will take part in a workshop alongside professionals at the center. In the evening, the group will take a tango lesson, followed by a 3-course dinner. After the meal, the group will watch a professional tango show.

Day 5:

The group will travel out of Buenos Aires to the small town of Gualaguay to learn about healthcare in rural regions. Night spent in Gualaguay.

Day 6:

The group will spend the day in Gualaguay at an early childhood development center, before heading back to Buenos Aires in the evening.

Day 7:

The group will take a day tour of Tigre and the Delta, including a picnic lunch.

Day 8:

The group will spend the day at a senior home, meeting with medical staff, professionals, and the patients. In the afternoon, the group will join the home's laughter-therapy class. In the evening, the group will join a mate workshop to learn about the culture and history of mate, followed by a language-exchange with a local mate club.

Day 9:

The group will tour around a public hospital in Buenos Aires, and then have the chance to meet and discuss practices with local doctors and nurses.

Day 10:

The group will spend the day at a traditional Argentine 'Dude Ranch'. Includes return transfers, welcome drink and empanada snack, Asado (BBQ) lunch with wine or beer, tour of the estate, Gaucho skill show, typical Argentinian folklore show with live music, and the opportunity to ride a horse

Day 11:

The group will have a free day to relax, sightsee, or shop for souvenirs. In the evening, there will be a Farewell Dinner in a traditional Argentinian restaurant.

Day 12:

The group will be transferred back to the Airport for their flight home.

Program Features

A. Pre-Departure Support

The group will receive comprehensive pre-departure support. World Endeavors staff members will be available to answer questions throughout the process and to assist with pre-departure orientation as requested. Prior to departure, participants will receive a pre-departure handbook, which will cover country-specific information as well as tips and guidelines for a successful international experience.

B. 24-hour Argentina-based support

Our experienced Buenos Aires-based coordinators will be available 24 hours a day to provide support for the group.

C. In-Country Orientation

Upon arriving in Buenos Aires, the group will receive an orientation from our local coordinator in in the city. This orientation will introduce them to Argentinian culture, health and safety issues, and the schedule for the program.

D. Group Accommodations

For Students – Shared rooms in a student residence (Separated by gender)
For Faculty – 1 private apartment with 2 bedrooms.

E. Meals

Breakfast is included each day (with the exception of arrival day), as well as some lunches, and three group dinners at local restaurants.

F. In-Country Transportation

Public transportation will be used within Buenos Aires. Private transfers will be used for group activities outside of Buenos Aires.

G. Airport Reception and Drop-off

Transfers to and from Ezeiza International Airport (EZE) International Airport.

H. Crash Course Spanish

Basic Spanish class inclusive of materials.
