Program Summary

The first week will be spent immersing yourself in Northern Peruvian culture, seeing the sites, and practicing your Spanish. For the second week, you will spend your time teaching English to local students.



Day 1: Sunday May 31st

- Arrive into Peru
- Airport greeting and transfer to accommodation
- Dinner at accommodation

Day 2: Monday June 1st

- Breakfast at accommodation
- Orientation day to familiarize the group with the surroundings, health and safety information, and local culture
- Lunch at accommodation
- Short hike to 'White Crosses Hill' where you can bathe in the thermal waters.
- Dinner at accommodation

Day 3: Tuesday June 2nd

- Breakfast at accommodation
- Visit to Granja Porcon, a beautiful spot to take in the breathtaking scenery of the Andes.
- Dinner at accommodation

Day 4: Wednesday June 3rd

- Breakfast at accommodation
- Visit to Cumbemayo, built around 1,500 BC and one of the oldest man-made structures found in South America.
- Dinner at accommodation

Day 5: Thursday June 4th

- Breakfast at accommodation
- Guided tour of Cajamarca and hike to the top of Santa Apolonia hill.
- Dinner at accommodation

Day 6: Friday June 5th

- Breakfast at accommodation
- Day trip to Namora to visit the local guitarra workshop, followed by a visit to Laguna San Nicolas to walk around the lake.
- Dinner at accommodation

Participants will stay at our center, in the small village of Puylucana, just outside of Cajamarca. The house is made with traditional materials such as adobe and stone, and it also has a large garden. depending on the project. The accommodation is dorm style with private bathrooms. There are refrigerators at the accommodation for participant’s convenience. The house has a garden as well as a volleyball court.

Program Inclusions

A. Pre-Departure Support

Participants will spend their first week on a cultural tour of the area surrounding Cajamarca
9 days volunteering during their stay.

H. Volunteering Project

Participants will spend 5 days volunteering during their second week

I. Comprehensive Travel Medical Insurance

Group participants will be enrolled in travel medical insurance, which also covers personal belongings.
